#### Guidelines:

- Action-oriented project
- Incorporates class readings/discussions
- Builds off student interest
- Focuses on a waste-related topic (can be human, solid, etc.)

### Instructor Assistance:

- Mentorship
- Connecting with other resources (readings, people power, etc.)
- Supplies

#### Evaluation:

- Engagement/involvement of stakeholders
- Implementation
- Thoroughness of project (research, design, evaluation and implementation)

#### Summary of Deliverables:

- Class presentation ( $\sim$ 15 20 minutes)
- Showcase Presentation (1 minute)
  - o Posters should be 36 x 24"
- Background report
- Project report/technology prototype/art installation

### Details of Deliverables for Final Project:

## • Class presentation

- o 15 18 minutes with 5 minutes for questions
- If you would like to invite anyone, please do; either guests or people who would benefit from hearing your work
- Presentation should cover the main elements of the report and of the summary of your project

# • Background report (4 - 5 pages; graphs in appendix)

- Introduction (What are you working on)
- o Background (why is this important, and how big is the opportunity/challenge)
- Context (where is this important, when, etc.)
- Your research process and findings
- What do you see as the key issues that you are trying to address?
- What is your proposal
  - Detail the elements of your proposal and how they evolved out of your findings
- Next steps in implementation
- Include images of whatever you developed (if it is a physical thing)

#### Project Showcase

- Two parts:
  - Make a poster: 36 x 24"
  - Make a slide to be used for a short pitch
- Include Project Name
- o Student's Name
- o Brief description of project
- Research Process and findings
- Key design factors in your project
- Context (how big is the issue/opportunity, competitors, etc.)
