


Strategies for Establishing Civilian Control

Expansion

- Mass conscription, tiny professional officer corps
- "Citizens' Army"
- Advocates: Machiavelli, Gary Hart
- Examples: Switzerland, Israel, Nicaragua (Sandinista People's Army)

Shrinkage and isolation

- Very small, professionalized army (at the extreme, abolition)
- Limit most dangerous branches (e.g., army)
- Advocates: Lázaro Cárdenas, Bill Perry
- Examples: Canada, Japan, Mexico (five times as many teachers), Panama, Costa Rica

Penetration

- Parallel civilian hierarchies with strict oversight at all levels; need for civilian expertise
- Advocate: Leon Trotsky, Dick Cheney
- Examples: USSR, U.S.

Fragmentation and hobbling

- Divide and conquer; create rival agencies and inter-service rivalry
- Examples: Libya, Venezuela, Mexico
